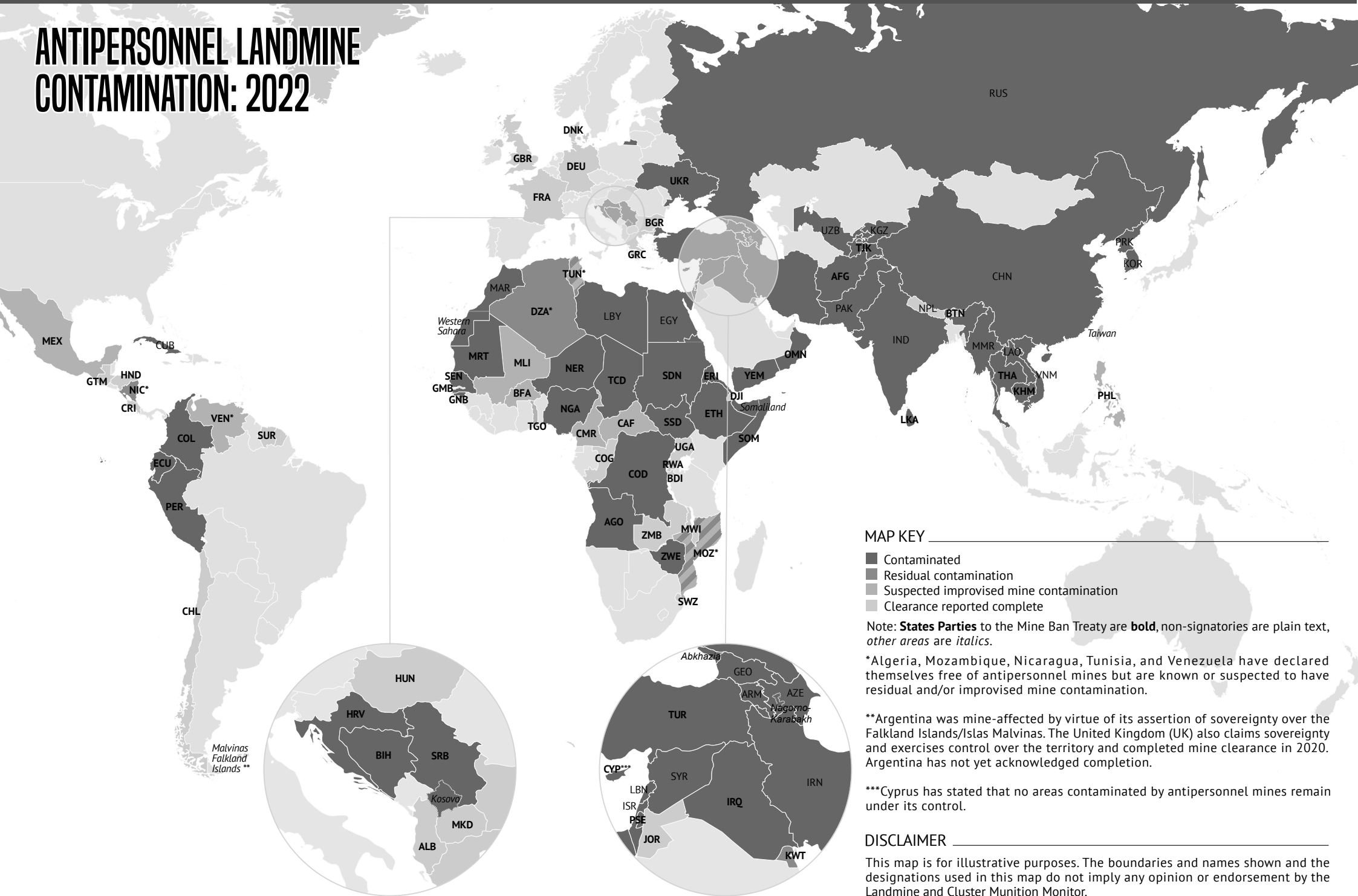


ANTIPERSONNEL LANDMINE CONTAMINATION: 2022

*Algeria, Mozambique, Nicaragua, Tunisia, and Venezuela have declared themselves free of antipersonnel mines but are known or suspected to have residual and/or improvised mine contamination.

**Argentina was mine-affected by virtue of its assertion of sovereignty over the Falkland Islands/Islands Malvinas. The United Kingdom (UK) also claims sovereignty and exercises control over the territory and completed mine clearance in 2020. Argentina has not yet acknowledged completion.

***Cyprus has stated that no areas contaminated by antipersonnel mines remain under its control.
